Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Assess, plan, implement, and evaluate patient care considering patient age, diagnosis, and developmental level.
- Formulates and implements patient plans of care; family is included when appropriate.
- Provides care appropriate to condition for pediatric or adolescent population.
- Observes and communicates pertinent information regarding patient mental status and behavior, occurrences, abnormal lab/diagnostic results, and/or negative response to treatment or intervention to physician and/or appropriate health care team members.
- Knowledgeable of medications, including psychotropic drugs, and their correct administration based on the age of the patient and their clinical condition.
- Demonstrates the ability to perform crisis intervention and triage.
- Utilizes verbal and physical de-escalation as warranted in order to keep patients safe and remain current in warranted certification and training.
- Communicates appropriately and clearly to the Nurse Executive, co-workers and physicians.
- Treats patients and families with respect and dignity; provides emotional support.
- Provides education to the patient and family concerning plans of care, compliance with the plan of care, medications and their side effects.
- Functions as a patient and family advocate at all times.
- Demonstrates the ability to be flexible, organized and function under stressful situations.
